Chardonnay

Without a doubt the most popular white wine variety at the present time. Australian chardonnay has moved away from over-use of oak to more elegant and seductive styles that are as good as any in the world.

A variety of flavours from citrus, melon and fig to stone fruit characters enhanced with complexity often underpinned by lees, malo and subtle oak.

A complex nose offers aromas of lifted figs, peach, lemon and fragrant nutmeg oak. The palate has depth and complexity, 'Penely Estate 'Aradia' Chardonnay has flavours of stone fruit, while a creamy long texture is enhanced by the layers developed from the 'wild' ferment.

Gewurztraminer

Truly an Alsace specialty, this white variety is pungent and full bodied with exotic aromas and a rich full bodied palate that has a clean finish.

The 'Tamar Ridge' has lychees and rose petals on the nose and this follows through onto the palate which is rich and exotic and goes on and on.

“Sometimes when I reflect back on all the wine I drink, I feel shame. Then I look into the glass and think about the workers in the vineyard and all their hopes and dreams. Pinot Gris/ Grigio

The Italian/ French connection is gaining popularity. These can be elegant and gently perfumed wines or luscious and creamy, almost unctuous and complex numbers. On the palate they can show minerality and grassy/herbaceous notes with hints of apricot and honeysuckle with great texture and length.

Pinot Noir

This variety seem to attract the most colorful descriptions from many a wine writer and enthusiast. Burgundy, where this grape possibly expresses “terroir” better than any other, is undoubtedly the ultimate benchmark. It typically shows dark berries to stewed plums on the nose underlined by truffles, fungal or barn yard tones. The mouth feel is rich and full, held up by tannins that are silky smooth, balanced with subtle oak and acid.

Cabernet Sauvignon

The King of reds displays aromas of cassis-accented fruit to more elegant dark berry with leafy or minty hints. It is often blended with small amounts of varieties such as Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot, the palate is big and full of flavour with some mouth puckering tannins to finish.
